Draft East Ayrshire Green Infrastructure and Green Network Strategy 2015

In line with the development of the East Ayrshire Local Development Plan, the East Ayrshire Open Space Strategy and Audit 2009 has been reviewed and updated to reflect current provision and current policy around Green Infrastructure. This aims to provide a co-ordinated approach to the provision of protected open space, development of local green space initiatives and the core path plan.

Throughout 2014, the East Ayrshire Council and East Ayrshire Leisure have carried out a review of the 2009 audit and strategy. This assessment looked at the quality of open space, its function and then considered local need and demand. This has been used to develop a Green Infrastructure and Green Network Strategy made up of 4 volumes:

Volume 1: Strategic Vision and Open Space Standards

Volume 2: Settlement Review and Green Network Action Plans

Volume 3: Cemetery Strategy

Volume 4: Biodiversity Delivery Plan 2015 – 2017
