MANAGED PARKS AND OPENSACES



The majority of the open spaces are located south of Barbieston Road towards the River Doon. The river itself defines two of the larger spaces and these are situated adjacent to the river.

The quantitative assessment from the 2015 audit outlines that Dalrymple has high numbers of open space in relation to the population, with most spaces being related to the River Doon which runs through the settlement. However, Skeldon House sits adjacent to the settlement and this provides additional open space accessible from the village.

SCHOOLS



Dalrymple Primary School and Early Childcare Centre is used regularly for community events and activities including dance classes and youth clubs activities. Dalrymple Community education Centre is in the same campus as the primary school. It is also used regularly for community activities including mother and toddler groups, a ukulele orchestra a handicraft group and a range of children's activities

EAST AYRSHIRE LEISURE FACILITIES



Dalrymple grass pitch and pavilion is situated in the heart of the village. It is used regularly by one football team. It is also used for children's outdoor activities.

PRIVATELY RUN FACILITIES



Springwater fisheries is situated in the heart of Dalrymple. The fishery provides opportunities for coarse fishing in its 3 acre, well stocked loch; fly fishing in 6 acres of freshwater and bait fishing for beginners and skill development. The fishery is open from 8am every day until dusk. The fishery is also an excellent site for wildlife watching.
