

FENWICK

MANAGED PARKS AND OPENSACES



The calculation for useable openspace in Fenwick is combined with Waterisde and Moscow. Despite the rural setting of these communities, there is a deficit of openspace within this area of over 4 hectares. The recommended open space of the combined settlements is 6.61 hectares, but the actual useable open space provision is only 2.4 hectares. This is made up of 2.2 hectares in Fenwick and Laigh Fenwick and 0.2 hectares in Moscow. There are no open spaces in waterside which meet the useable open space criteria.

As well as regular school events and activities, **Fenwick Primary School** is regularly used for Fenwick Community Council meetings

COMMUNITY LED FACILITIES



John Fulton Hall in Fenwick was taken into community management by Ayrshire Communities Enterprise through an asset transfer arrangement. Its main hall has a capacity of 150, making it ideal for a range of private events and functions. As well as regular fitness classes, clubs and meetings, John Fulton Hall hosts a number of seasonal markets throughout the year.

Fenwick Pitch and Pavilion has been leased to a local football team for their regular games and training sessions

PRIVATELY RUN FACILITIES



Sansa Fit is a private gym base in Fenwick. Within the gym, they have a range of free weights and cardiovascular exercise machines. They also offer one to one personal training which includes nutritional advice.

Craufurdland Castle and Country Estate is situated on the outskirts of Fenwick. This family run estates specialises in outdoor activities including fishing, treetop trails, forest fitness classes, mountain bike trails, archery and a range of team building activities.

The Estate includes the Laird's Table Restaurant and wee café to suit the needs of all visitors to the area and can support a range of private functions including weddings and corporate events.
