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# HURLFORD & CROOKEDHOLM

## MANAGED PARKS AND OPENSACES



Hurlford and Crookedholm have a low quantity of space in relation to the population. The recommended value of open space is 21.87 hectares and the actual value is 14.7 hectares, resulting in a deficit of over 7 hectares. Richardson Park which provides opportunities for a range of activities.

The **Chris Hoy Cycle Route** is well used route which connects to the Irvine Valley Path network. It has been constructed on a dismantled railway line from Mauchline Road in Hurlford to Galston where it picks up a number of other local routes.

## SCHOOLS



**Hurlford Primary School and Early Childhood Centre** is currently only used for school activities such as parent council meetings and parents' nights. It is not generally used for community use out with school hours.

## EAST AYRSHIRE LEISURE FACILITIES



**Richardson Park** grass pitch and pavilion is situated on Mauchline Road in Hurlford. It is used regularly by one football team.

## COMMUNITY LED FACILITIES



**Hurlford United Junior Football Club** is a very successful junior football team who play from Blair Park. Blair Park is an all standing venue and has a covered enclosure halfway down one side that easily holds a good 50 people. There is a refreshments kiosk in the grounds.

**Hurlford Community Centre** is managed by Hurlford Community Association. Open seven days a week, the centre is a popular part of the community and offers a wide range of activities including Christmas shows and children's parties.
