Each group will be split into bubbles depending on attendance numbers and current Covid regulations at the beginning of each term.

All participants will take part in 3 x 40 minute workshop sessions.

Sessions will take place in Art Hall 1, Art Hall 2 and the Main Hall.

All rehearsal spaces are of suitable size to allow for physical distancing and have been selected so that each student has sufficient personal space to adhere to guidelines/physical distancing measures.
