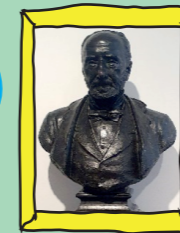


Hamish Haggis says...Dae ye ken?!?

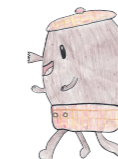

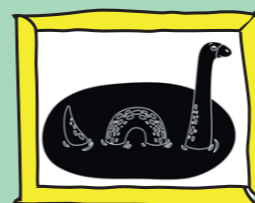

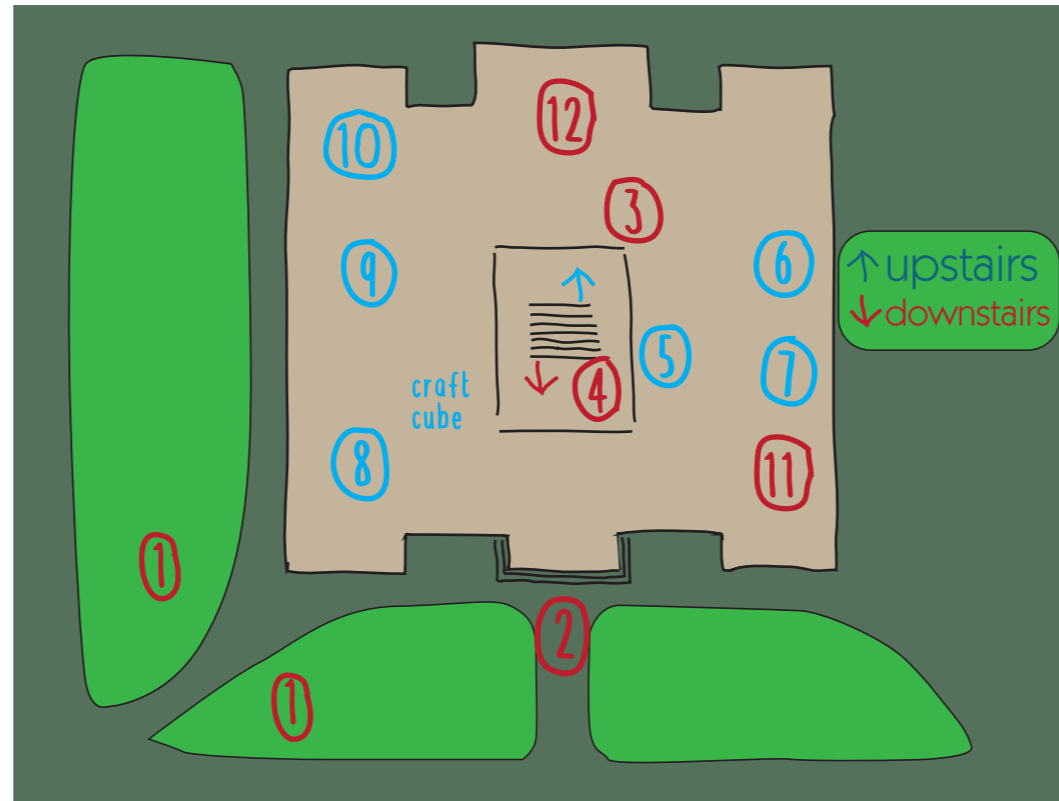
